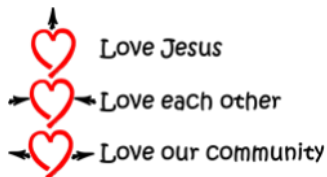

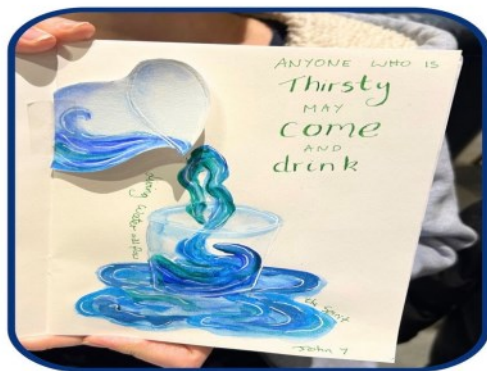

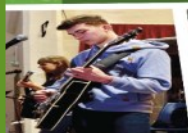

**PRAY HEMEL** Good day everyone (yes, even me) in this beautiful Autumn's (or should I say winter's, given the o/n temperatures) sunshine. I have been told to walk a lot so the weather is very pleasing. Enough rambling, at least verbally. **The next Pray Hemel on Saturday October 4th will be hosted by: Grace Communion International Church at Bennetts End Community Centre, Gatecroft, Hemel Hempstead HP3 9LZ.** Plenty of parking at the shops with a Pelican, Albatross or whatever bird type it is traffic light-controlled crossing ready to see you across Leys Road straight to the Community Centre. The surgery starts flu injections on Oct 4th and while these begin after 9am, it is neighbourly not to use that car park. There is parking behind the surgery, but it is frankly much better to use the shops as the access road to the surgery is narrow and complicates. There is also legal off-road parking all around, usually with available spaces outside St Benedicts on Peascroft Rd and top end of Barnacres. **Refreshments will be served from 8.am; worship and prayers begin at 8.30 am.** Shirley, our wonderfully active CTHH Secretary, and her team are very much looking forward to welcoming us to this location where they started worshipping earlier this year.
